

## SIGWEB Student Travel Award Program Program Information – DocEng 2014

The SIGWEB Student Travel Award Program is intended to help student authors attend SIGWEB conferences. Awards are administered by the SIGWEB Executive Committee, which delegates the task to a particular SIGWEB officer.

Student Travel Awards are given to authors who are currently students or who were students at the time of submission of their papers. Preference in awards is given to students who are first authors and will present the paper at DocEng 2014. The size of the award given is based on the funds available for the particular conference and the student's expected travel expenses. Awards are typically larger for authors of full papers.

To apply for a SIGWEB Student Travel Award for DocEng 2014, the student should submit the following:

- 1. A completed application form
- 2. A resume
- 3. A letter of support from the student's research advisor
